Seeing is believing

The cynics can now eat their words as the first stage of the foreshore erosion works is now complete. David McCorkell, our assiduous Foreshore Project Manager, has correspondence going back to 1967 relating to this problem. Over the years the issue has been vigorously pursued by Doris Hoffman, Una and Arthur Carpenter, Adrian Riepsamen, Mick O'Donnell and son, Kate Carr and many others.

In the six years that David has been involved, he rates the formation of the Get to the Point Programme as a real turning point with action from Council being noticeable as of that time.

The rock revetment, two groynes and the dinghy skid for the first stage, from Albert Avenue south to the mangroves, is complete except for minor landscaping remediation work. By the time you read this, the damage to the grass should have been repaired and mulching and planting at the top of the revetment been completed. Let's all take care of this work and be proactive in deterring vandals.

Tenders have been called for the next stage i.e. from the point (Bongers') South of the mangroves to the existing boat ramp. The main feature of this work will be a large groyne on the point and a smaller one approximately mid-way between the point and the ramp. Council is scheduling this work to commence within the next two months.

The design process for the boat ramp and jetty is scheduled to commence in July and will include seeking development consent with construction to commence in July 2007 (albeit using Council's well known phrase "subject to the availability of funds").

Your letters (you will be writing won't you?) to Council and Councillors highlighting the need for a ramp leading to deeper water and a jetty with disabled access should hopefully encourage Council to identify the required funds.

Some people have complained that the works caused some "dust". Earthworks of this nature create dust; the result is a benefit to many but especially those with homes fronting the reserve. Anyone with some idea of how to carry it out without dust could become very rich.
