## **GENERAL BUSINESS**

The family of the Late Tom & Teresa Gibbins have asked GTTP's help in getting a Commemorative Bench (Teresa Gibbins was a very active community member). This is being pursued through council.

Peter has received request for steps into swimming pool for the use of the frail & less able bodied persons. The pool already has a chair for this purpose. Steps would be very expensive and would put at least 1 lane out of action.

GP Highway sign: Offer to re-erect from and an offer to refinish from Peter at Nowra Signs.

GP School will not be holding the Oyster & Fishing Festival this year. People were asking about the Easter Fete over Easter weekend. Should we have some other community function? Insurance needs to be checked.

South St Wharf: Cllr Watson advised that wharf will be fixed at cost of \$5800, Winch is unsafe. Slipway is no longer used.

Fix for dingy ramp Albert St, temporary fix with conveyer belt mats (Lake Conjola has plastic ramp)

Groyne (Albert St) : half demolished, children used this as a diving platform.

Path Lights: some are not working? Have to check which ones. The Company that provided lights is no longer in business so spare parts may not be available.

Large lamp on wharf interferes with Navigation Light. Dave McCorkell said he will attend to this.

Cllr Greg Watson advised that a series of Budget Meetings will be announced. Expect rate increases 2017-18.
