Foreshore – Fresh Erosion. Bank is falling away in sections along the reserve. – Letter to be submitted to council. - Ongoing, letter still not sent as of this meeting.

Tennis Court – New net has been replaced. Basketball back board has collapsed and needs replacing or repairing. President to follow up.

Greenwell Point Boat Launching Ramp and Car park. The Committee, after discussion, decided that an appropriate sign on the pontoon could read “Boats have right of way” and an appropriate sign in the car park could read “Cars with Boat Trailer have Priority”. Secretary to email Michael Strachan, Project Manager and advise.

Community Sign for Greenwell Point. More discussions were held to look at the viability of a sign on the approach to Greenwell Point detailing a directory of what is available in the village. The position of the sign is to be determined along with the details.

Historical Berry Wharf. Great historical ruin. Was once the 2nd biggest Port in NSW. It is historically listed.

Greenwell Point Road – It was brought to the notice of the committee that a dangerous occurrence is happening on the road. The area is just after the first bend on leaving the township. It is where the cattle cross. As the area is usually covered in dirt and cow manure, the road, when wet becomes very slippery. On one occasion a vehicle lose control and ended up in the ditch, luckily without serious injury. Other vehicles have been observed when going through this patch to lose traction and swerve slightly.
