

8. Other Business.

Drains : Meeting was held at council chambers between Ben Stewart SCC, Councillor Watson & Ken Knight, Colleen Milne & Bob Williamson from Greenwell Point. Issues discussed draft drains report & other issues to do with drains in Greenwell Point. Discussion included removal of upturn at end of drain in church street, increase or duplicate pipe to end of church street, new drain in easement in Adelaide street, what involved in sending water via West street & maintenance of all drains. Ben Stewart to forward response to GTTP, there was no time given for the response or completion of the draft report.

Jemma mentioned that Ben Stuart (Shoalhaven Council) is committed to maintenance of the area.

Ken Knights made the comment that Greenwell Point gets very little in terms of spending by Shoalhaven Council.
(ACTION – ongoing)

Chemist Shop Path: The path to the Chemist Shop is near completion.

Greenwell Point road east of Pyree Lane: Jemma Tribe will speak to Ben Stuart regarding the parlous state of Greenwell Point road east of Pyree Lane. Drivers moving towards the centre & sometimes over it to avoid the conditions (ACTION – Gemma Tribe)

Greenwell Point Rd & Pyree Lane: Karen Knowles email re Greenwell Point Rd & Pyree Lane merging issues. Tabled and read to those in attendance

General Road & footpath maintenance: Ann Williamson will photograph hazards to walkers on our paths and roads.

Jemma Tribe suggested the use of “snap send solve” app for iPhone, iPad & androids. This sends the photo directly to appropriate person in relevant council.

Handrails in ladies toilets at Swimming Pool: This was mentioned from the floor of the difficulty faced by some users of these toilets. ACTION – (Jemma Tribe will mention to Ben Stuart)

Town Signage: New horizontal signs were fixed to the communities that needed them. Greenwell Point has the old vertical sign and in rusted condition. Gemma advised that no further action will be taken on these signs until after the merger has been sorted out.(ACTION-Hold)

“Knit & Natter” Tanya. A women’s group has been formed The Group intends meetings at 10am to 1 pm on Wednesdays in the Hall. Shoalhaven Neighbourhood Centre is providing training for 5 volunteers; group will come under their ‘umbrella’, an application to waive the hall rent until end of financial year sent to SCC.
