Proceedings:

1. Welcome

President welcomed the mighty throng swelled attracted by attendees from the preceding presentation on the Goodnight Island Tourist Development Proposal. He circulated some stuff.

2. Previous Minutes

Minutes taken as read.

3. Business Outstanding from Previous Minutes

- a) GTTPP T-shirts – Vera (with modelling assistance from the Pres') presented the new t-shirts to be offered for sale through local businesses. Apart from a change to the logo to include Greenwell Point the samples were delightedly accepted, the model got a few wolf whistles and Vera received a resounding vote of acceptance and thanks.
- b) Draft Foreshore Plan of Management – Public comment period lapsed 10 May with no submissions being received. Council committee has recommended to Council that Plan be adopted. No response yet to letter requesting funds for tennis court.
- c) Gazette advertising. Most people now up to date or withdrawn, Laurel and Vera have drummed up 6 new potential advertisers.
- d) Parking restrictions – discussion concluded that proposed no-parking signs were acceptable but that we should report visibility problems at junction of Reg Wilson Way and Greenwell Point Road and seek extension of no parking zone to west of RWW or make RWW one-way.
- e) Speed limit changes – Gazette poll resulted in 29 against and 8 in favour of reducing the speed limit between Worrigea and Greenwell Point. Clr Kerr has proposed a change to 90Km. Poll results to be reported to Council

4. Financial Report

As at 30 April assets stood at \$13,380.85. Net profit of \$92.00 was recorded for April 2006.

5. Council Issues.

a) Draft Plan of Management 2006 -2009

Secretary reported parlous level of funding proposed for Greenwell Point projects in 2006/2007 - only \$80,000 for boat ramp design and nothing for foreshore erosion or park. Submission to be prepared to go to Council.

b) 6-Monthly Principle Consultative Body Meeting

The next meeting is on 31 May and will be attended by Messrs Bannister and McCorkell. The question of a marina has been put on the agenda – no further agenda items were forthcoming.

c) Flood Plain Management Plan - Status

In response to a letter seeking an update on this plan, Council's Martin Bergs has reported that the plan was delayed due to work required to assess the Tallowa Dam implications. Further status will be reported at the Flood Plain Management Committee meeting in June.

d) Marina Status

A letter was sent to Council seeking advice on the status of the review into this issue. No response received to date. Issue put on agenda for PCB meeting as above.

e) Community Garden Policy

Secretary advised of potential to get Council support for a Community Garden but no one showed too much interest in doing anything about following up on the idea.

f) Foreshore Erosion Works

Meeting decided a letter of thanks should be sent to Council for the works completed so far.

6. Team Leader Reports

a) Social Development, Physical Design, Business and Tourism

No report.

b) Events

Car Boot Sale happening June Long Weekend. Christmas-in-Winter event has gone cold. Post meeting suggestion of free plum pudding and custard to attract attendees to July AGM!

7. General Business

a) Goodnight Island Development Proposal

Overall positive reception to the presentation and the concept.

b) AGM – 20 July

Reminder that all present office bearers are standing down at the AGM and are not available or re-election.

c) Park Naming Competition

A late entry from Jim Walliss was declared the winner – Titania Park. Titania is the name of a historically significant early steam boat (and as subsequently discovered is also the Queen of the Fairies!).

d) Phone Boxes

Telstra plan to remove phone boxes in West Street and Greens Road. No objections raised.
