## BUSINESS

- Michelle from the Art class explained how the class is planning to raise money to forward to people in Vanuatu affected by the cyclone/floods etc. They decided to sell one pastel each and the money raised to go back to this area. They thought the local school was a good venue to display the art – say on polling day. It was suggested that they consult the school Principal. The committee and community can help. Maybe the church grounds could be another venue.
- Michelle also mentioned the state of the long grass on the property on the Jervis Street & Greenwell Point Road corner. Is this Telstra property? She contacted council and lodged a complaint and they said they will get back to her. Dave brought up that it is Telstra land and a few shrubs have been planted. Council has some plans for that land. Kay Murray knows about it. [PT to pursue]
- Laine said that the property next door to the Hall – where building work is going on - has an uneven footpath and could be very dangerous for marchers on Anzac day. The RSL is looking into the condition of the area especially with Anzac march soon. Since there will be police and other marshals on duty on Anzac morning it is expected that the small dangerous area will be cordoned off.
- Joe Franklin pointed out that a bad accident is very likely to happen at the corner of South Street near the Marine Rescue shed. This needs to be brought to Council's attention. The area is used by school kids etc. Many users seem to cut the corner and run the risk of hitting a vehicle coming the other way.
