Minutes General Meeting April 20th, 2017

Meeting opened by Grahame Ross President at 7 pm.

General Business (With our two councillors present, it was a spontaneous decision to move on to GB out of normal order.)

- Bob Williamson mentioned that Men's Shed volunteers spent 360 hours preparing for & painting the Inside of the Hall. It was expressed that this was carried out by a "handful" of people.
- Grahame mentioned the dip in the gutter outside the hall presenting an obstacle and using the Secretary's failure to negotiate this successfully as an example as to why the council should repair this prior to ANZAC Day.
Moved that this be repaired by Bob Williamson, Seconded by Grahame Ross.
- The problem with the undermining of the 15 metres of Pathway is partially caused by water diverting from the Carpark adjoining the Boat Ramp. This is to be rectified by Council.
- The CCB Executive Meeting is 11th May at council advised by Crs Pakes & Gash
- Crs Pakes & Gash advised that the Timber Wharf is presenting a hazard and will be removed as a matter of urgency. It is proposed that Funds will be made available to replace this wharf with a Pontoon type structure.

- Ken has again repeated his request that Jim Wilds legally parked Oyster Van be moved as it is causing a hazard. It has been observed that parked immediately in front of Jim's van is another vehicle similar in size to Jim's. If Jim does move his up, then it may well just leave a space for another legally parked vehicle. Further discussion.
