### SHOALHAVEN HEADS ESTUARY TASKFORCE

Bob Williamson attended the SHET meeting 22/7. Water quality is good.  
Next meeting is 23<sup>rd</sup> September, possibly no solution will be reached in the near future.  
The Study using oranges was a gimmick to get people to attend and get their ideas.  
Greg Watson explained some of the history behind the many studies that have been done on Shoalhaven Heads.

### CCB

Councillors Familiarity Tour 31/7. Tour started at RFS site to view proposed site of GP Mens Shed, and moved on to the West St Slipway, then to Adelaide St, where the lowest area is subject to flooding. On to Albert Street the proposed location of kayak slides, the Fishing Wharf where the proposed Pump Out facility would be located. Councillors left the bus to view the erosion of the foreshore at Anzac Park, it has possibly eroded another metre since last year's visit. The bus then travelled down Jervis and along South St, where the breaking up of the road surface on the corner in front of the Marine Rescue Bldg. was pointed out, this is a danger to pedestrians cyclists and other road users.
