## GENERAL BUSINESS

- **Tennis court resurfacing** – Darryl McLean to approach council to negotiate for their contribution as per SCC Letter dated 11/03/08 from Gary Girdlestone, Sports Field Officer. .
- **Bank Restoration.** On 12<sup>th</sup> March Dave McCorkell attended a meeting of the Shoalhaven River Natural Resources & Floodplain Management Committee and was pleasantly surprised to be informed that Stage 4 (the final stage) of the River Bank Restoration was to be underway in the next couple of weeks. The area concerned extends from the recently completed work near Church Street to Albert Avenue. Two fishing platforms similar to the one at the Northern end of Titania Park will be constructed, one at each end of this work. Also in the near future, landscape work will be carried out to the Northern end of the Swimming Pool, the section of Titania Park near the Children’s Playground that is being eroded by stormwater from the car park and will gain some rock protection and a concrete pad will be constructed to enable wheelchair access to the fishing platform.
- **Anzac Park** – Jim Carr has done an excellent job in Anzac Park after a tentative start due to heavy rain. The work includes the first section of the bike/walking path as shown in the Master Plan. The sandstone for the feature wall has been delivered and will be placed by Greenwell Point weekender Tony Gassman (stonemason).

- **New Boat Ramps and Parking Area.** Council advises that tenders will be called in approximately 2 weeks
- **Vandalism.** All misdemeanours should be reported. It is advised that residents contact the Police Assistance Number 131444 and reports all incidents. Not only vandalism but any inappropriate behaviour involving motor vehicles and alcohol related incidents should also be reported.
- **Renew Registration of Business Name.** Registration Certificate has been received and Vera Farnham will place a copy of the certificate in the Notice Board outside the RSL Hall.
- **Drainage Problem.** Letter was sent to Council.
- **State of local Roads.** The road outside the Pharmacy has been made safe.
- **Tourism Board** – Vera Farnham has been approached by the Tourism Board to produce a brochure on Greenwell Point. Vera will liaise with local businesses for financial assistance.
- **WebPage** – Graham Bannister has updated the webpage which can be access at <http://www.greenwellpoint.info/> The website contains a lot of information and is updated regularly. Graham has done a great job but unfortunately will be leaving us. Dave McCorkell will continue updating this website.
- **Council Correspondence.** It was discussed at this meeting that not enough notice is being received for attendance at meetings. Notice of meetings is being received on the day they are being held.
